

LA 2.1: Share Cultural Artifacts

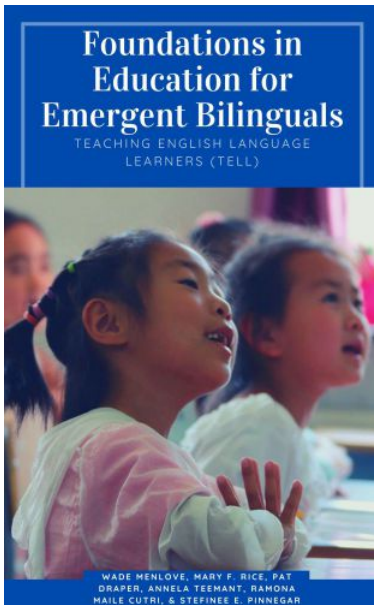

<p>Communicate a personal acceptance of culture and acknowledge the dynamics of culture in the lives of all students. Assessment: 25 pts. TA: 30 Minutes</p>	<p>Teachers understand that every person has a culture to be appreciated and that utilizing parts of students' cultures as they work with ELs makes learning more accessible.</p>	<p>After learning about culture and its impact on learning, students are ready to identify characteristics of themselves as cultural beings and bring artifacts and descriptions to share with others.</p>

Instructions

1. Before class, set up your Cultural Artifacts with 3x5 cards on a table provided by the teacher. You have 15 minutes to peruse the artifacts others brought.
2. Working in your group, you will discuss what you learned (10 minutes)
3. Now the facilitator will engage you in a shower of ideas where each group will share an idea or wonder you developed as you looked at the artifacts of your colleagues
