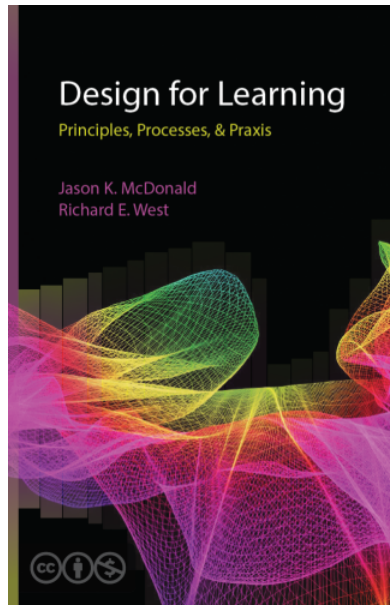


Design Relationships
